

III to V

- One Block period slot in a day for one subject
- Each slot would be comprising of 80 minutes
- The session will comprise of curriculum for skill development, experiential learning and competencybased assessment.

VI to VIII

- Two Block periods slots in a day for two subjects
- Each slot would be comprising of 80 minutes

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The session will comprise of curriculum deliverance, activities, and assessments. It would help to reflect on learning gaps in a particular concept and addressing it at the earliest.

IX to XII

- Two Block periods slots in a day for two subjects
- Each slot would be comprising of 100 minutes.
- The session will comprise of curriculum deliverance, activities, and assessments. It would help to reflect on learning gaps in a particular concept and addressing it at the earliest.

Block Periods will be introduced across classes to help teachers conduct experiential learning and competency-based assessment on weekly basis

Grade IX and XI

• NEP (National Education Policy) mandates students in grades IX/X to study three languages.

Among the three languages, at least **two must be native to India**.

• In grade XI, the "two languages formula" is to be implemented.

At least **one** of the languages studied in grade XI must be native to India.

Note: There has been no circular from the CBSE end related to the implementation of three and two language formula in grade IX and XI respectively as of now.

In the upcoming session new languages will be started as a Club and classes would be held once in a week in Activity Club period. Once circular is received from CBSE cell, languages(Sanskrit/Hindi) would be embedded in the regular timetable.

Subject combinations for Grade XI (No hard separation of Streams)

- NCF (National Curriculum Framework) suggests a myriad of subject combinations for students.
- The Data is being collected from the students through a google form
- Counselling of students will be done after the board exam for allotment of different subject combinations depending upon availability of faculty and resources


Way Forward :

- Hybrid teaching learning can be implemented

Strengthening Emotional Quotient and Enhancing inclusivity

The School has a tie up with MyPeegu to train staff and parents for teaching children to understand their strengths and weaknesses, their overall personal and emotional development to set realistic goals and build self-confidence.

Costing : 35000/- per month for the Students, Staff and Parents.

Professional Enrichment and Enhancement Programme for the staff

- School has collaborated with ICSL to facilitate staff training aligned with NEP/NCF reforms. (2 years)
- Training program conceptualized in September 2022 to equip academic and co-curricular teams with new content delivery methods.
- Focus on **Competency-based teaching** as against traditional teaching
- Training sessions conducted four times a week via Zoom platform for accessibility and convenience.
- As of the current date, staff members have attended **65 sessions** and **147.5 hours** of training.
- The training program aims to empower staff with the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively implement changes mandated by NEP/NCF.
- Costing 85000/- + GST per month (Rs. 714 per staff member per month). It also includes session for parents and students.
